Dear Director Marootian:

I am writing to ask for your help in not closing H Street, N.W. from 22nd to 21st Streets as included in yesterday's George Washington University (GWU) document captioned "Plan for Fall 2020" which was submitted to the DC Office of Planning and the DC Department of Health for review. Today, the Board of the West End Citizens Association (WECA) passed a unanimous resolution opposed to any closure of H Street, N.W. in Foggy Bottom.

H Street is one of only two 2-way streets south of Pennsylvania Avenue in Foggy Bottom. The other one – I Street – has a one-block break from 24th Street to 23rd Street and ends just before 20th Street. In contrast, H Street is the only two-way street which runs fully from 25th Street to 19th Street. H Street is heavily used by residential and commercial vehicles traveling both East and West in Foggy Bottom and by vehicles trying to avoid the dangerous Washington Circle. Previous traffic studies in the area evidenced how important H Street is to functioning traffic.

Thank you in advance for protecting the quality of life and livability in Foggy Bottom.
