The featured speaker will be Ward 2 Councilmember Brooke Pinto. In addition, Brian Joyner, National Park Service (NPS) Superintendent for Rock Creek Park, will address Federal parkland in Foggy Bottom West End, including the restoration work planned in Rawlins Park (18<sup>th</sup> Street to the East, E Street to the South & North, & 19<sup>th</sup> Street to the West) and possible 250<sup>th</sup> Birthday plans on Federal land in Foggy Bottom West End. He became Superintendent in October 2024.

Councilmember Pinto was sworn in as Ward 2's Councilmember on June 27, 2020. Her current term will end on January 2, 2029. She recently announced that she will be a candidate for DC's Delegate to Congress, which is currently the Honorable Eleanor Holmes Norton. The DC primary for the Delegate race will be on June 16, 2026.

Councilmember Pinto earned her B.S. from Cornell's School of Hotel Administration and is a graduate of Georgetown Law School. She is Chair of the Council Committee on the Judiciary and Public Safety.
