The Summer Meeting of the West End Citizens Association (WECA) will be held on **Saturday, June 20, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. in GWU Duques Hall - room 152, 2201 G Street, NW. Please enter on 22nd Street.**

New Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) Second Police District Commander Christopher Dorsey will be the featured speaker. In addition, the George Washington University (GWU) will address its progress to date in its proposed changes from the current 20-year 2007-2027 Campus Plan to the next 20-year “Campus Plan 2027.” The current Campus Plan retained the identical Foggy Bottom Campus Plan boundaries as its predecessor and identified 16 potential development sites.

Commander Dorsey began his MPD career in 2006. From 2006 to May 2026, he held various positions in several MPD Police Districts other than in the Second District. In September 2024, he was promoted to Commander of the Seventh District and, on May 4, 2026, he was named Commander of the Second District, which includes Foggy Bottom-West End. Commander Dorsey earned a Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice from the University of Maryland and a Master of Arts in Security Studies from the Naval Postgraduate School.
